What Should You Expect?

The future on track work experience programme is aimed at 14-17 year olds who have an interest in science, technology, engineering, and maths (STEM) or rail industry careers. On offer will be some exciting management, leadership, and business innovation workshops as well as exposure to some of the countries leading forces in the engineering sector. Successful applicants will spend time both within Network Rail's London offices and maintenance delivery units, as well as with external consultancy partner ARUP, developing soft skills, independence, and to gain better understanding of the opportunities technical and non technical roles in the industry.



Who Should Apply?

Anyone and everyone who wants to pursue a STEM career, or who has an interest in STEM subjects! This doesn't exclude those interested in other areas such as economics, human resources (HR), design, finance, communications, project delivery. Applicants will be required to demonstrate motivation and interest in working in the rail industry. Academic aptitude is not the decisive factor and when short listing applicants wider skills and behaviours will be considered. Think creatively! What do you think the industry needs?



Application Process and Information

Applicants will be required to submit a full cover letter and CV which demonstrates their motivation and interest in the industry or careers associated.

The programme will take place from **9 July 2018 – 21 July 2018** with the possibility of a 3 day placement the following week. The deadline for applications is the **end of March 2018** and students will be advised of their success by April.
