

Dear Parents,


In order to help students prepare effectively for their A Level **exams**, Eltham College allow Upper Sixth to commence Study Leave once the main exam period has started. During this time normal lessons will be suspended and students are only required to attend school for their exams. Teachers will be available via email, should any additional guidance be needed.

- The main period of examinations begins on **Monday 4th June 2018**. Before this period all Upper Sixth students will remain in full attendance at school until the end of the school day on **Friday 25th May 2018**.
- From **Monday 4th June 2018**, normal lessons will be suspended during the period of examinations. Staff will still be contactable via email or in person to help students with any aspect of revision. The library will be available for private study.
- Some pupils find it helpful to revise at home in the final days before exams. Accordingly, if they wish to study at home from **Monday 4th June 2018**, and, if their parents agree, they do not need to come into school other than for their exams.
- Students who have exams before the official Study Leave period commences are permitted to have a half-day of study leave before the exam. This is either an afternoon before a 9am exam or the morning before a 1pm exam.

A Level Results day will be Thursday 16th of August. Please do not book holidays over this day.
