



Senior School core rules

1. All students are expected to show respect, courtesy and kindness towards others.
2. All students should act with integrity and honesty. This includes conforming to all School policies.
3. All students should arrive promptly to lessons, ready to learn, with the correct equipment.
4. Form rooms are to be treated with respect. Students who arrive before 8.15am should go to the KGH or library. There should be no running or shouting on the corridors.
5. Mobile phones should be out of sight and silent during the course of the day. They should only be used in lessons with permission from a teacher. Any phone that disrupts a lesson will be confiscated. The KGH and all corridors are mobile phone free zones. Students are responsible for the security of their phones.
6. All students must conform to the dress code at all times. All items of uniform and belongings should be clearly labelled.
7. Litter should be placed in the bins. Food and snacks may be consumed in the Sixth Form common room, Link Café and on outside benches; there should be no eating in classrooms.
8. Bags should be placed in lockers, form rooms or on bag racks where available. Students are responsible for the safety of their personal property.
9. Chewing gum, smoking, vaping or possessing illegal substances, defacing school property or stealing are not allowed and will be dealt with severely.
10. No student is permitted to bring alcohol onto the school premises, or consume alcohol in school, or on trips, except for sixth form students at official events, with prior permission and under supervision.
